



Module 3: Video 2 Transcript, Multisensory Learning Hearing Impairment



When a learner has a hearing loss, it's unlikely that they will be totally deaf. However, things may be difficult to hear even when you have a mild hearing loss.

Listen now as we simulate a conductive hearing loss in this busy classroom

It sounds more like someone has turned down the volume overall,

it sounds muffled and a little like being under water.

Turning the volume up or seating a child in a space which is closer to the sound can help.

Listen now as we simulate sensorineural hearing loss.

It can sound like the volume is OK, but that people just sound like they are mumbling.

Turning the volume up or seating a child in a space which is closer to the sound can help, but not as much as with conductive hearing loss.
