Bubble Tubes



The first thing most people see in a sensory room is a bubble tube and there are two different types of tubes.

There are the professional tubes which can cost around £500 and some which have switches to control the colours and bubbles, with a good quality switchable bubble tube often costing upwards of £1000.

However, there are also domestic grade bubble tubes which are much cheaper often found in shops for under £50.

Bubble tubes have been popular for nearly 30 years because they are a great tool for relaxation, visual stimulation and touch work for learners who may be tactile defensive.
