



## Module 7: Video 3 Transcript, Multisensory Learning Sensory Corners and 'Sensory on a Shoestring' Blackout Tents



Making the classroom dark is often difficult and blackout blinds can be really expensive so here's a cheap solution from the high street retailer 'Mountain Warehouse'. At around £50 this creates a totally dark space.

Carefully cut the bottom out of the tent and then you can place the tent over a wheelchair or quickly remove the tent when you need to.

This could be an instant escape space for learners who have autism or a fabulous pop up space for visual work and those UV science lessons that need the dark.

And when you've finished pop it back into its bag.

Pop up black out tents fabulous!
