Sound to Light Box



Sound to light walls are great for encouraging speech in sensory rooms but they often cost hundreds of pounds so here's a cheap way to recreate the effect.

On amazon these are called strobe bars and under £15 they have an automatic lighting mode, or you can make them light up with your voice

They can also be used as a little switch, because a light tap on the box will create enough sound for the light bar to light.

Put the sound to light bar into a plastic storage box and then use foil or a survival blanket and you have your very own sound to light box.
